

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF WOOLPIT PARISH COUNCIL HELD AT  
7.00 P.M. ON MONDAY 15 APRIL 2013 IN WOOLPIT INSTITUTE

**Present:** Mr Wiley (Chairman), Mrs Cook, Mr Melvin, Mr Lomax, Mr Guyler, Mr Hardiman, Mrs Parker and 3 members of the public.

1. **Apologies for absence** were received from Mr Jones.

2. **To receive declarations of interest.**

Mrs Cook declared an interest in application 0533/13 and duly signed the interest book.

3. **Planning.**

**0533/13** Erection of 3 bedroom bungalow and creation of new vehicular access.

Provision of car parking area for existing bungalow. 23 Steeles Road – object.

Access and proximity of driveway to current dwelling unacceptable, overdevelopment of site, new dwelling will be overlooked on all sides, loss of privacy and amenity for adjoining property. It is noted that the current dwelling is a two storey house not a bungalow as stated by MSDC.

**3390/12** Two class base standalone building. Woolpit Primary school – permission granted.

**3830/12** Single storey side extension. 4 Mitre Close. MSDC decision – permission granted.

**3809/12** Erection of industrial building (Class B1 & B2 & B8) with hard standing, car parking and new access. Land to rear of Coren, Rattlesden Road. MSDC decision – permission granted.

4. **To approve accounts for payment**

5. **To discuss making representation to MSDC regarding alcohol license for Costcutters at the garage site, Old Stowmarket Road and take any action.**

It was agreed to send a letter of objection as it may cause a public nuisance and could harm young children with the proximity beside the children's play area and recreation ground.
