- Woolpit is identified as a Key Service Centre in Policy CS1 of the Mid Suffolk Core Strategy DPD (Adopted Sept 2008)
- Local Services in Woolpit include: a Primary School, Health Centre, Post Office, Grocery Store, Garage/Convenience Store, Bakers, Butchers and two Pubs / Restaurants.
- 31.7% of all household with at least one usual resident in Woolpit are reliant on oil-fired heating. Just under a half of all households (49.7%) have access to gas central heating. [ONS 2011 Census: QS415EW]
